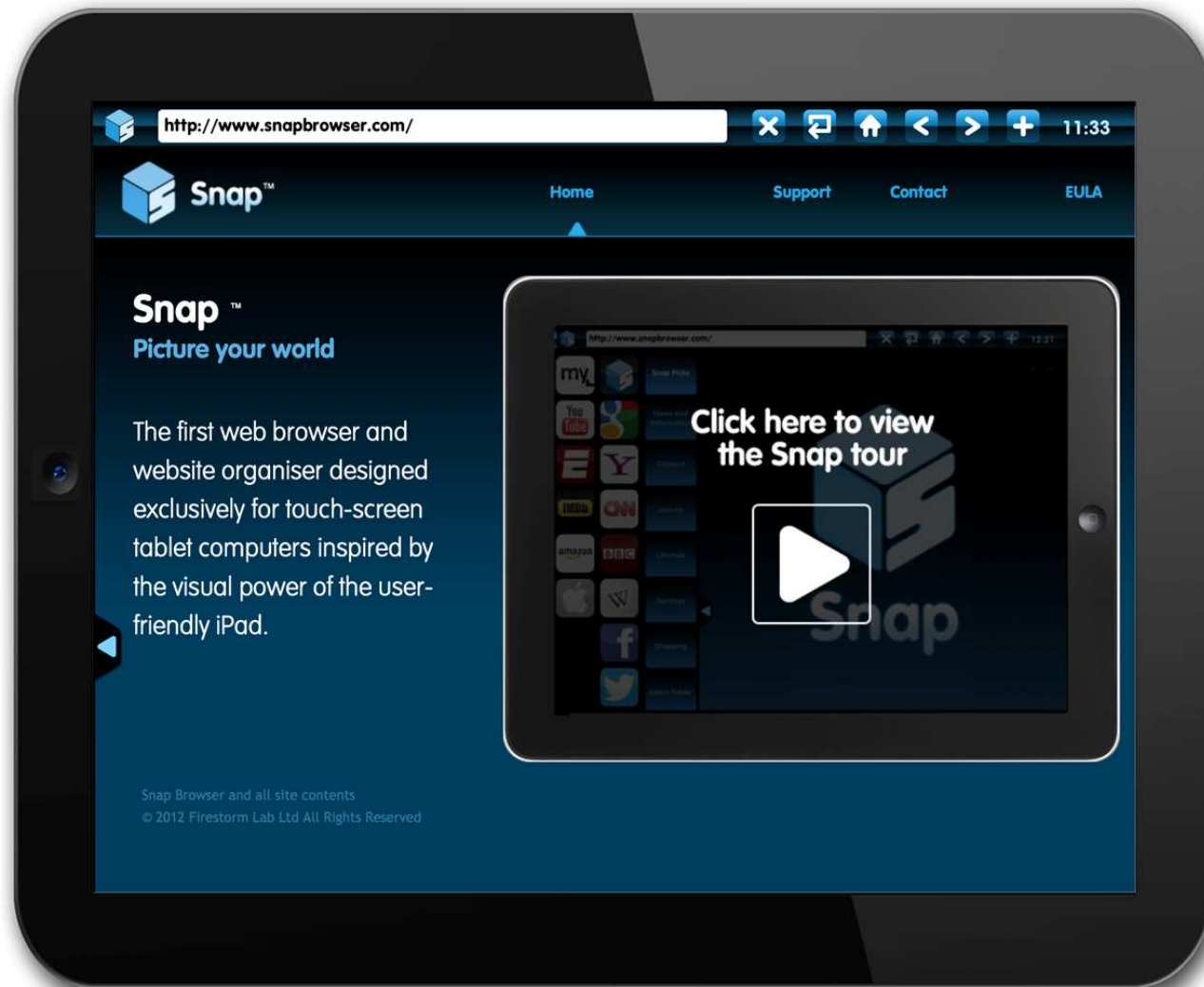

Snap™ boots up in less than ten seconds

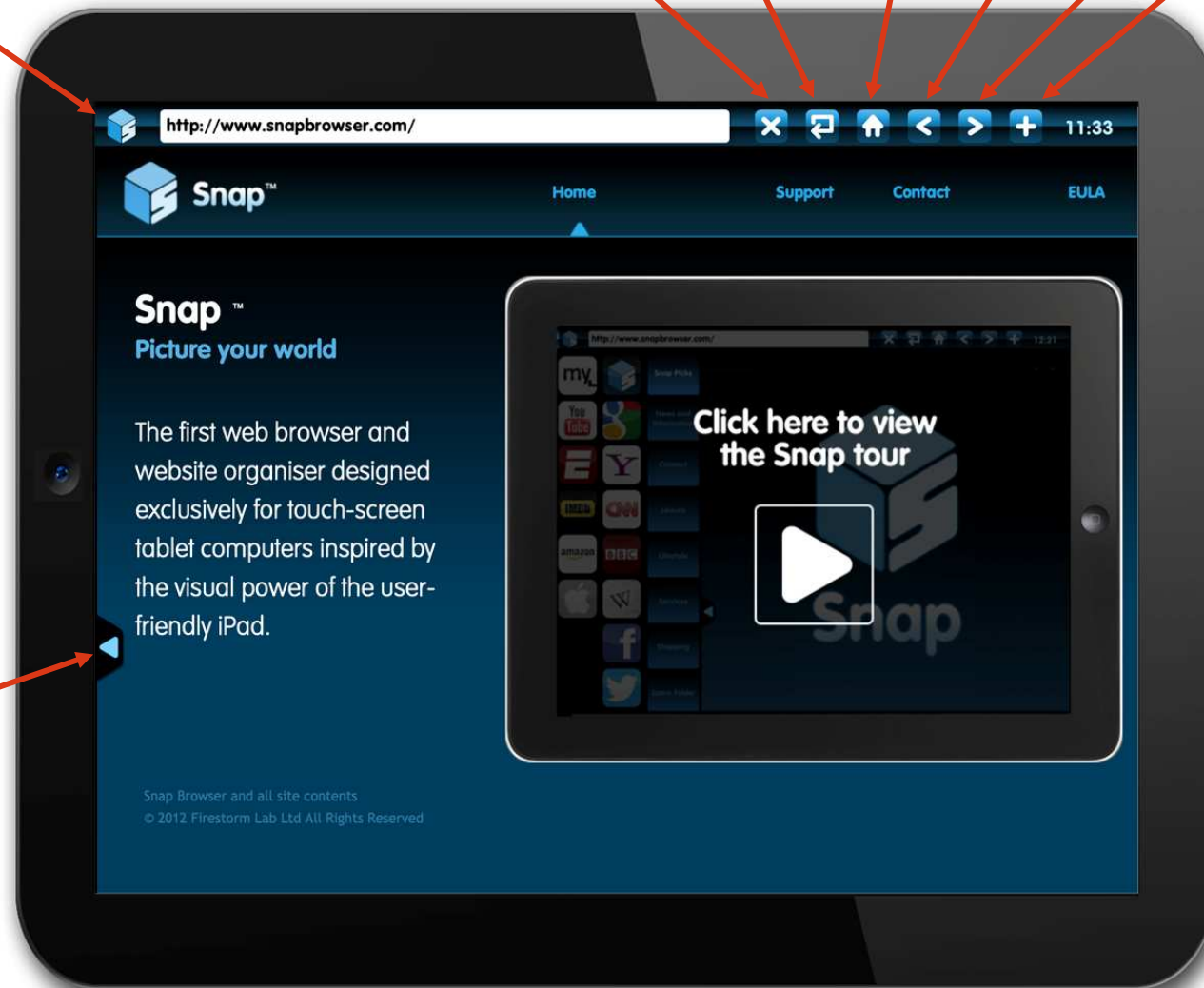


The Snap™ Home Screen, by default this is Snap™
but you can make any saved website your home page

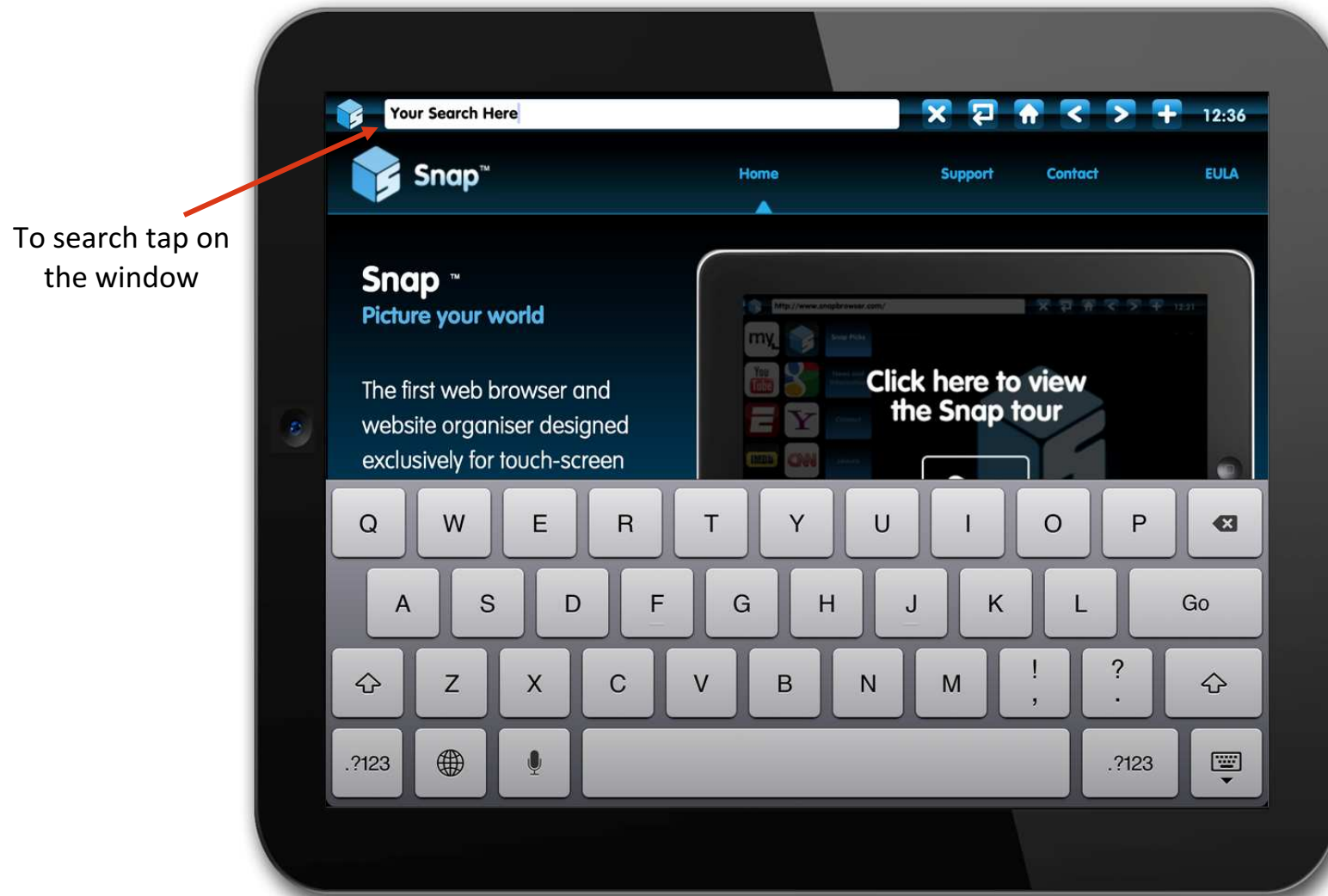

Snap™ is pre-installed with popular websites to get you started.
As Snap™ evolves you will be able to load many sets from around the world



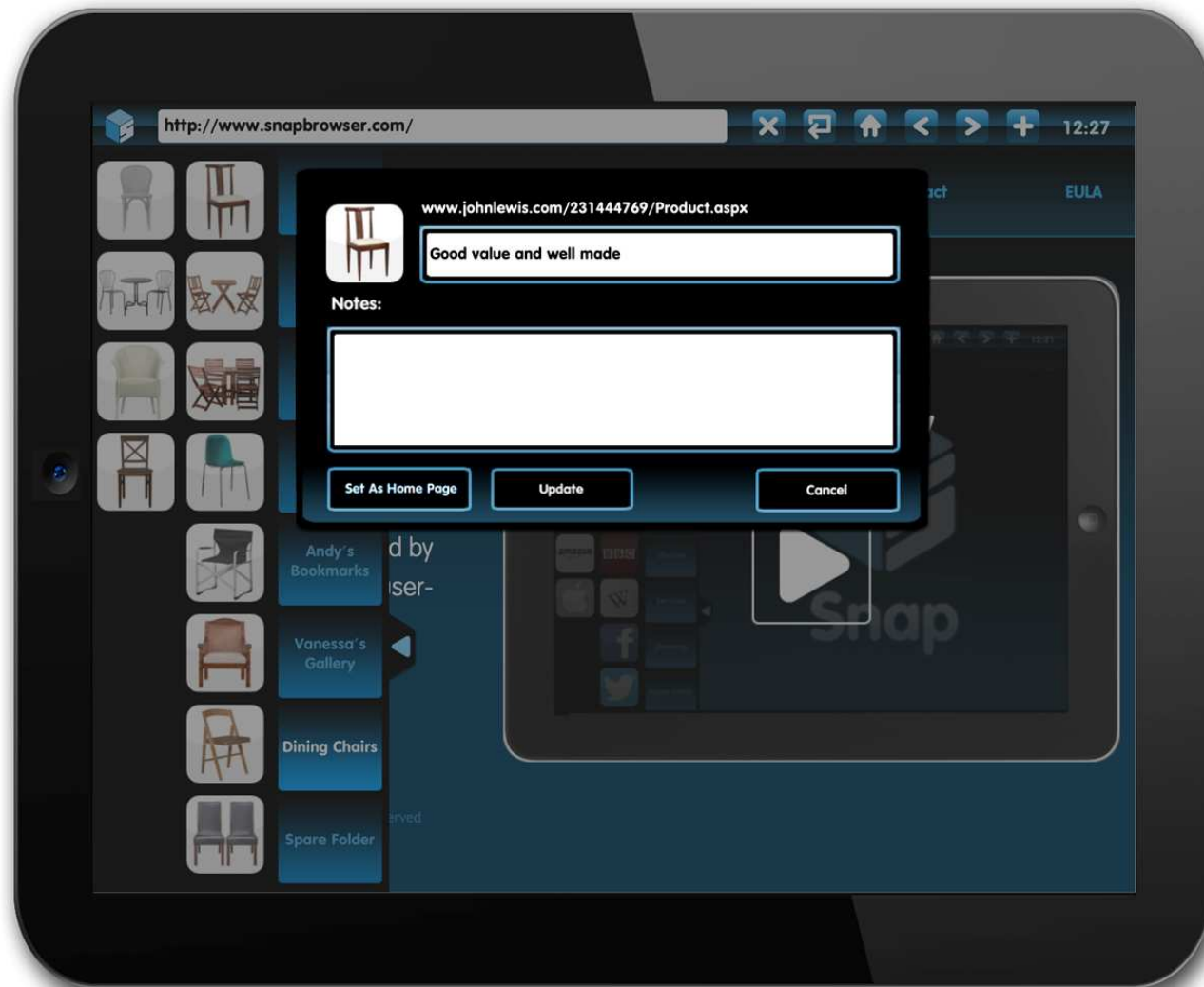
Tabs can be scrolled up and down, deleted and renamed.
Icons can be rearranged within folders and moved between them



You can Snap™ your own icons, or 'Mycons'™, to save as links to favourite websites.



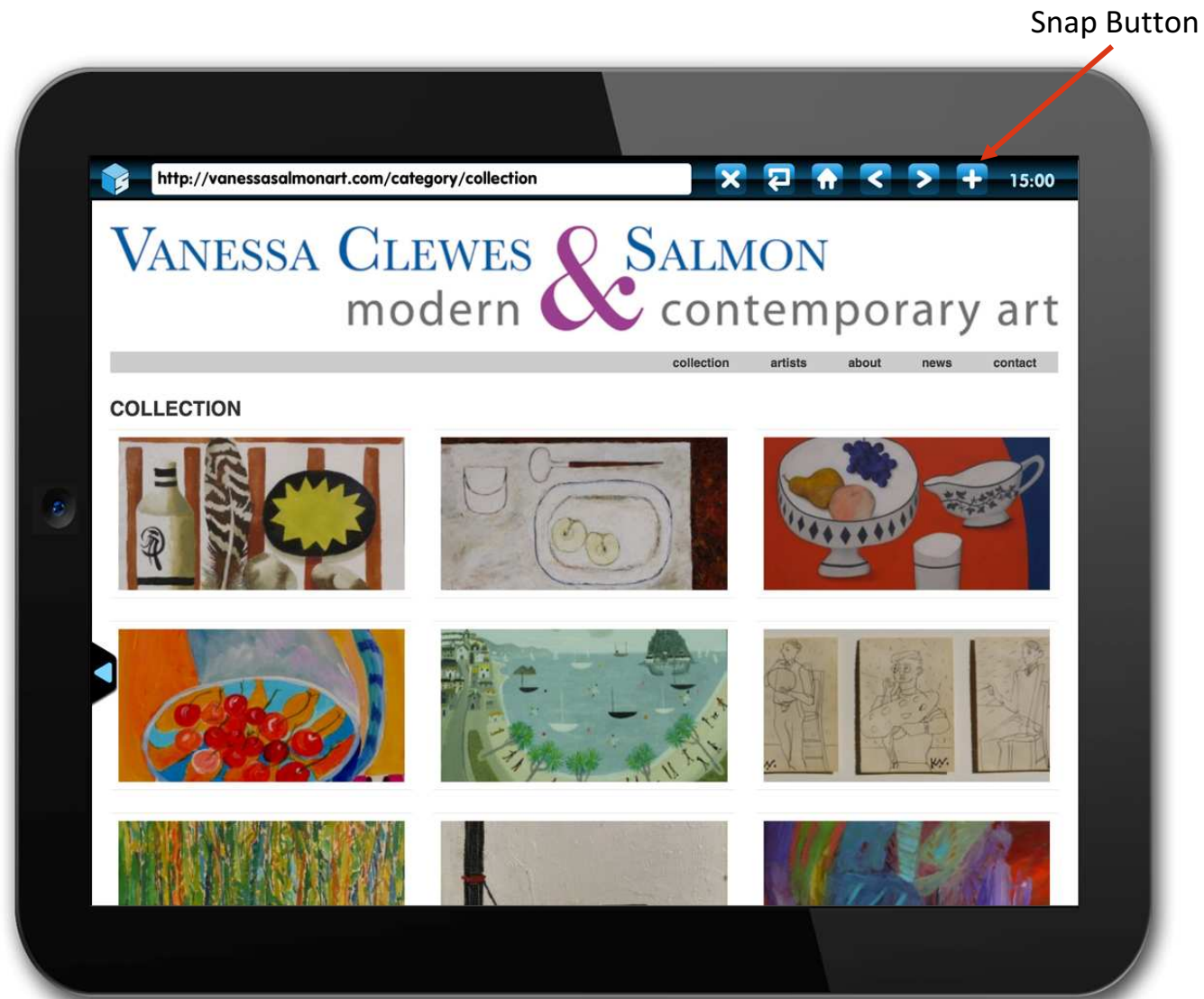
Mycons™ are a powerful way of organising and remembering your websites. You can create unlimited numbers of folders, each with up to 64 Mycons™



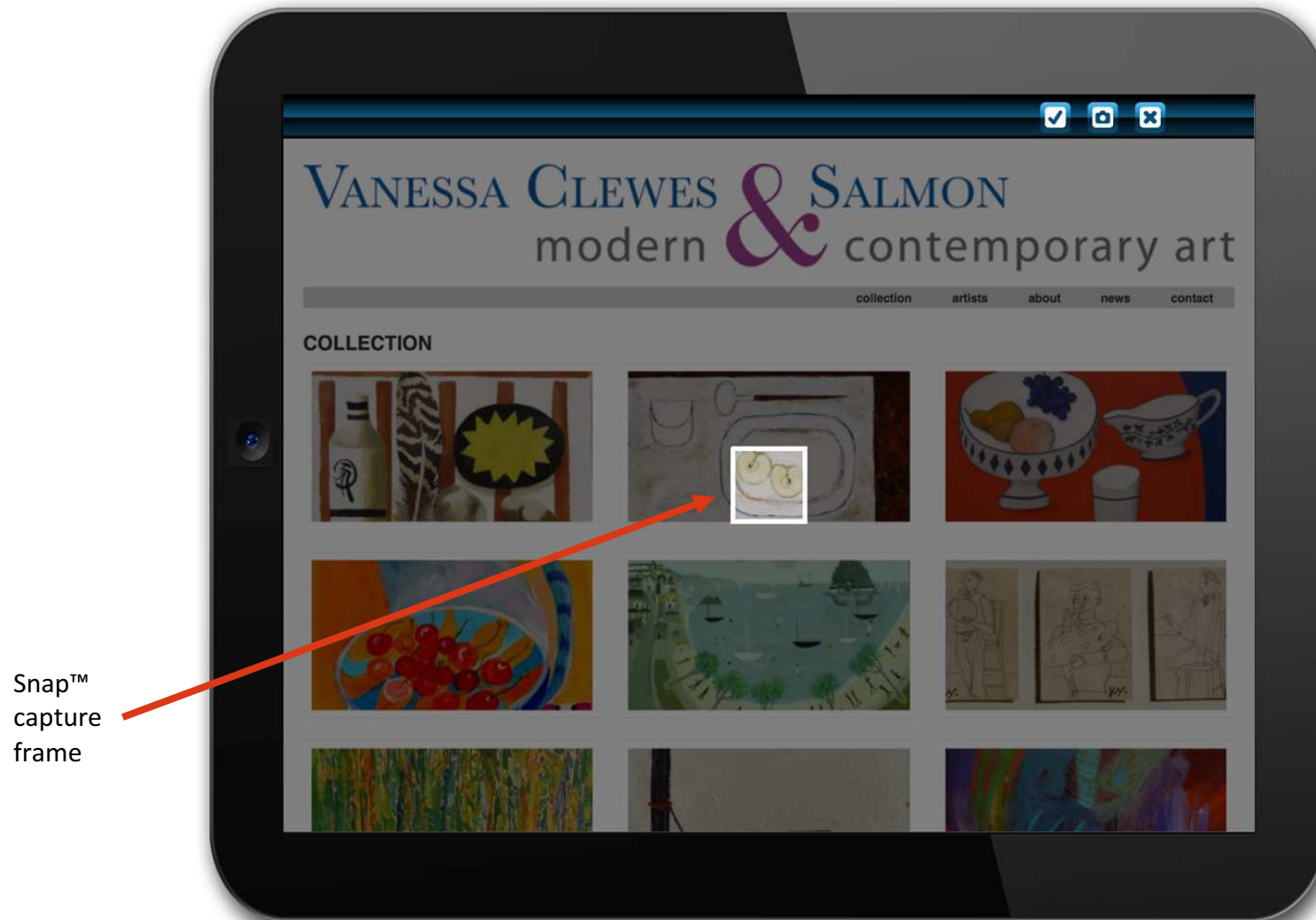
Double tapping on a Mycon™ or icon and you can also add your own notes



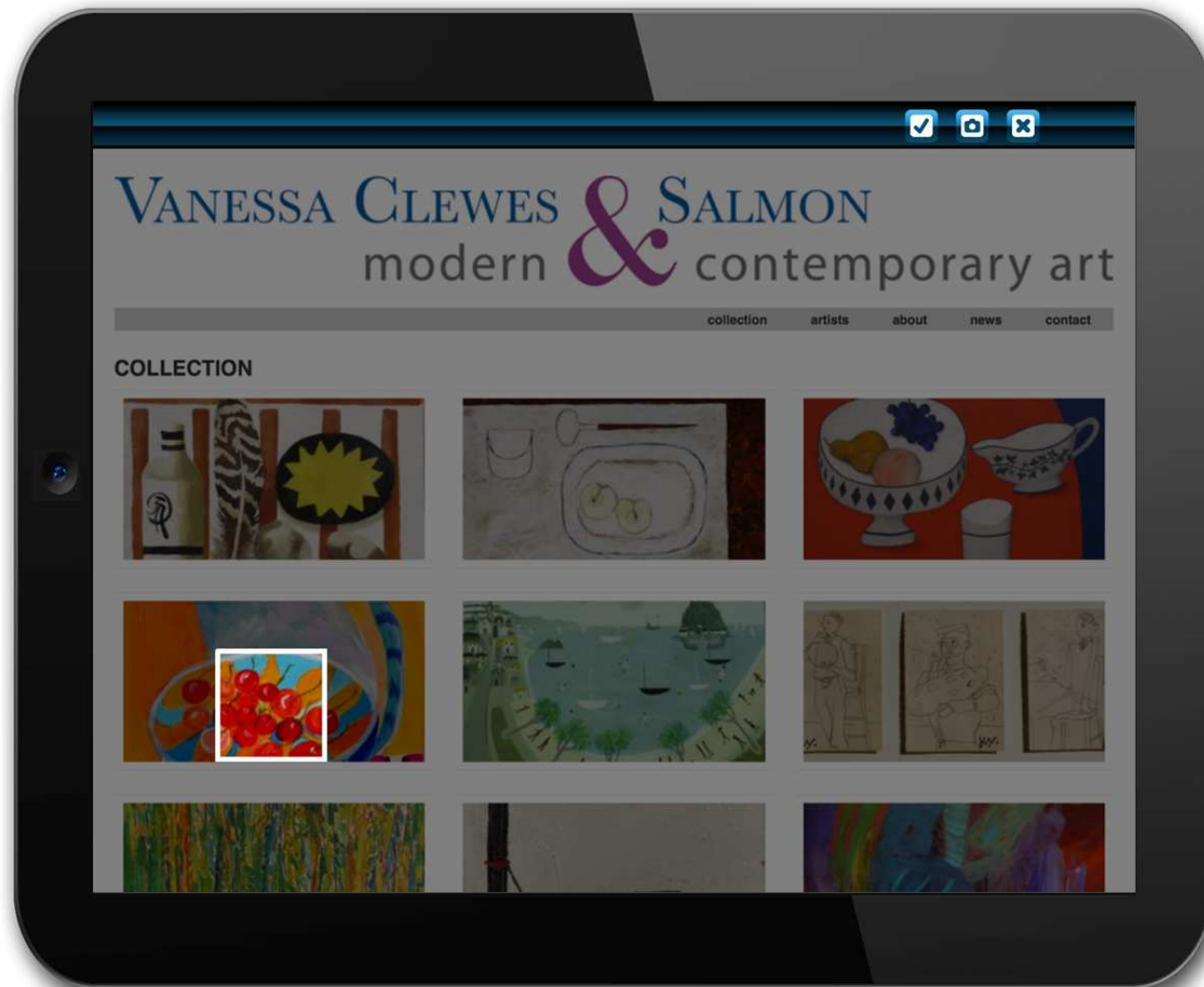
When you have added your notes tap on 'Update' to save



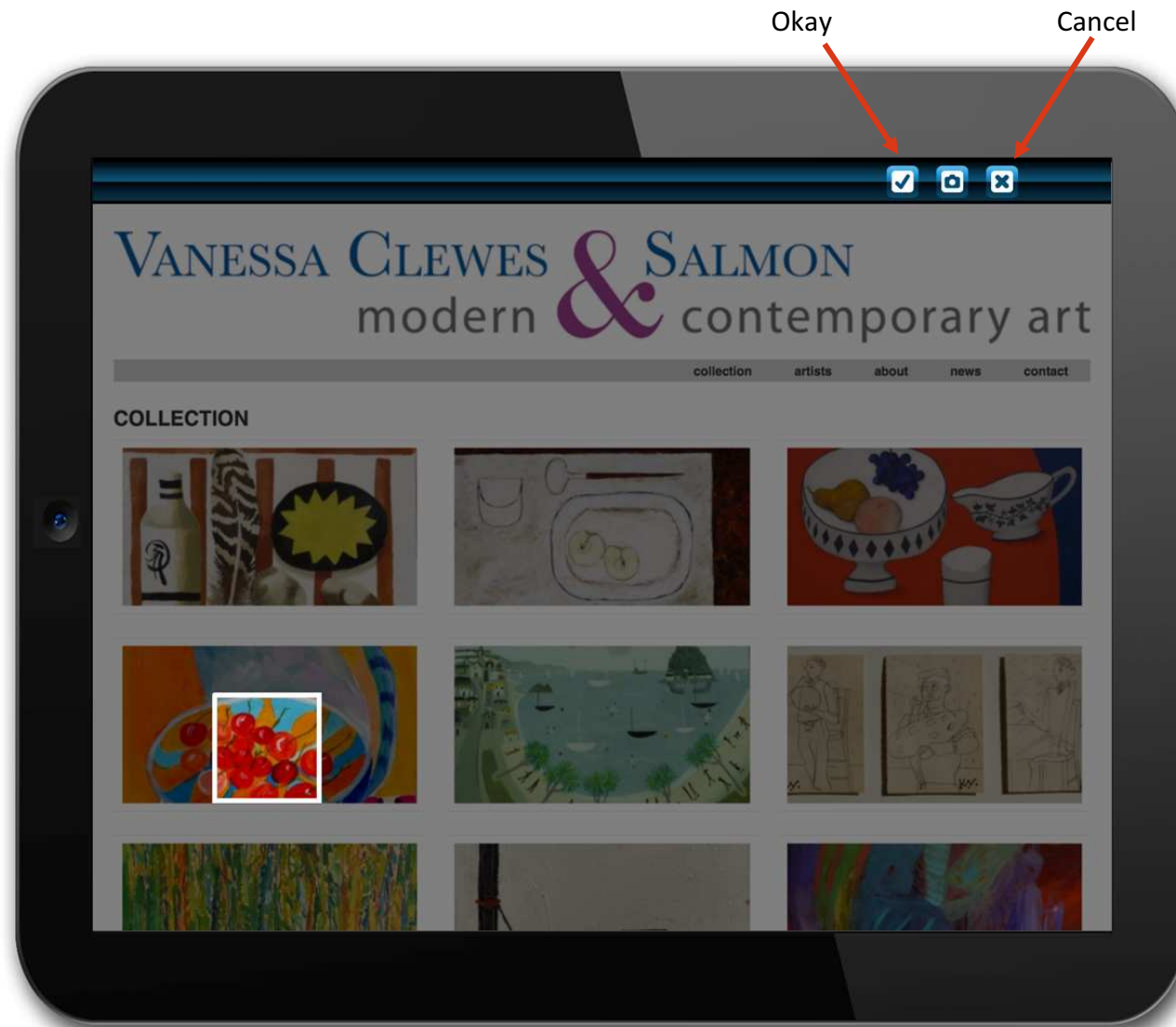
To save a website with a Mycon™ linked to it, you tap on the Snap™ button



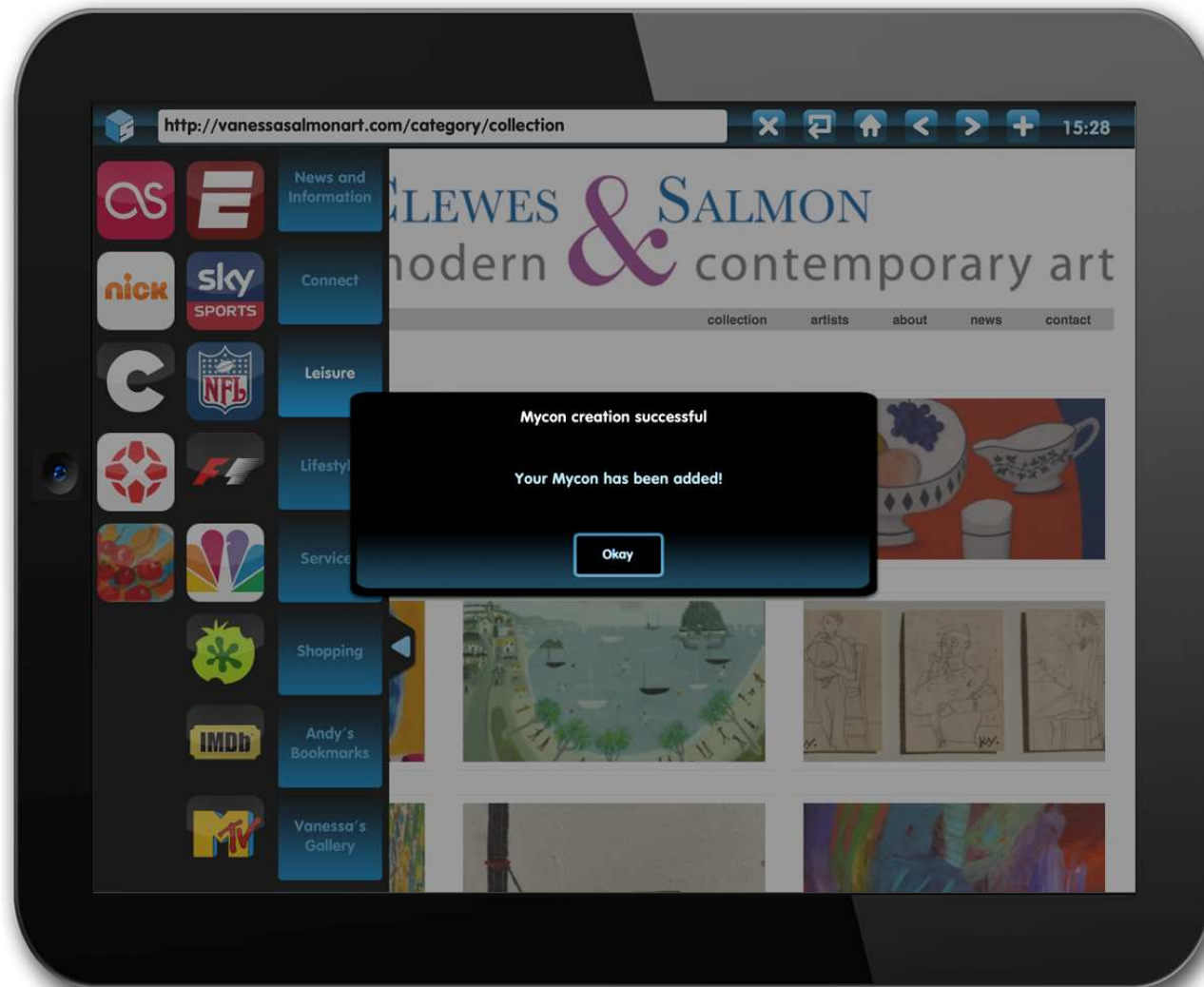
You can create a Mycon™ from any area of the website you are viewing by moving the Snap™ capture frame to any memorable area on the screen



You size the Snap™ capture frame by pinching it.
Then position it on the webpage to sample that detailed image



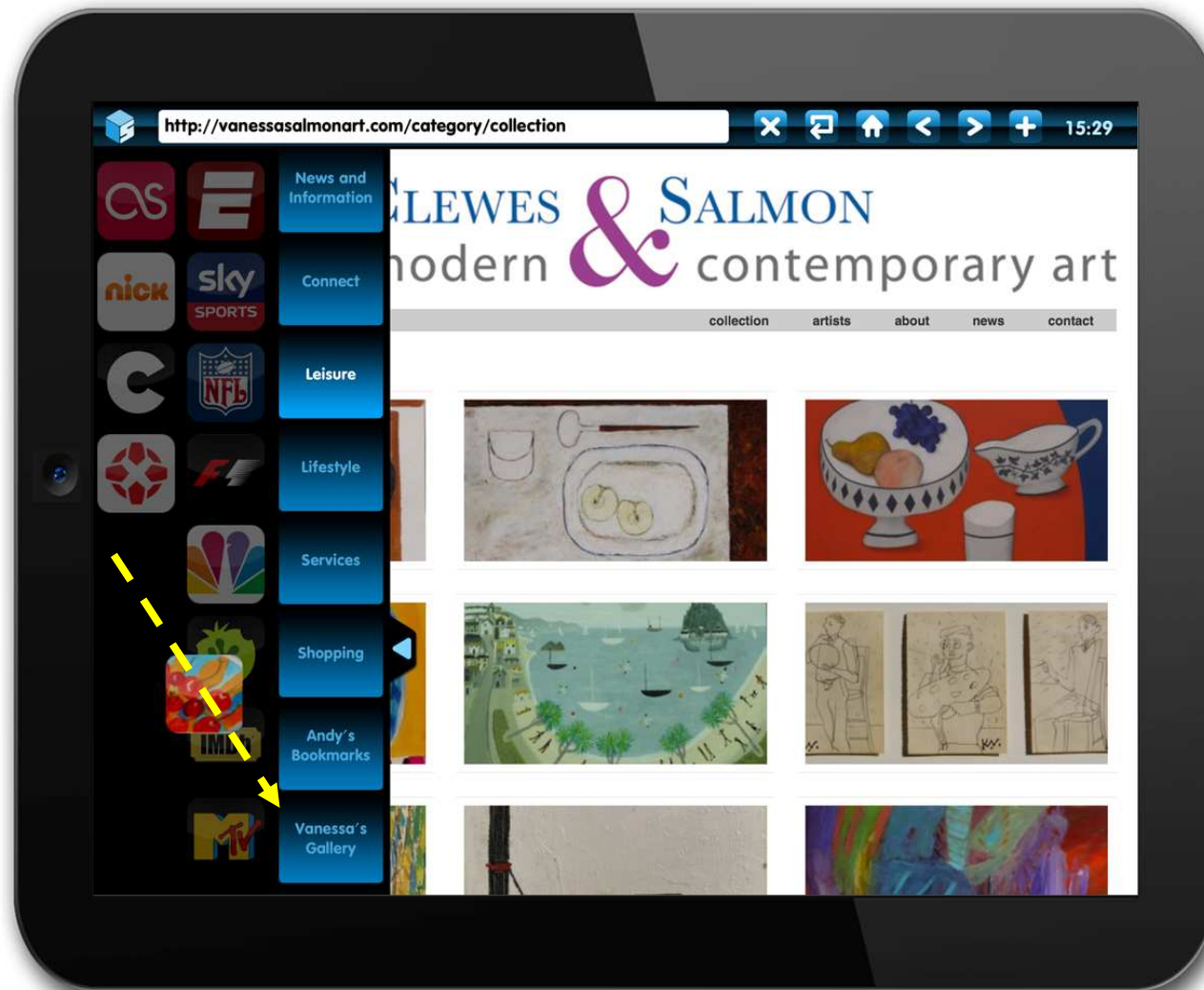
Tapping on the “☑” button saves the Mycon™, “X” cancels the save



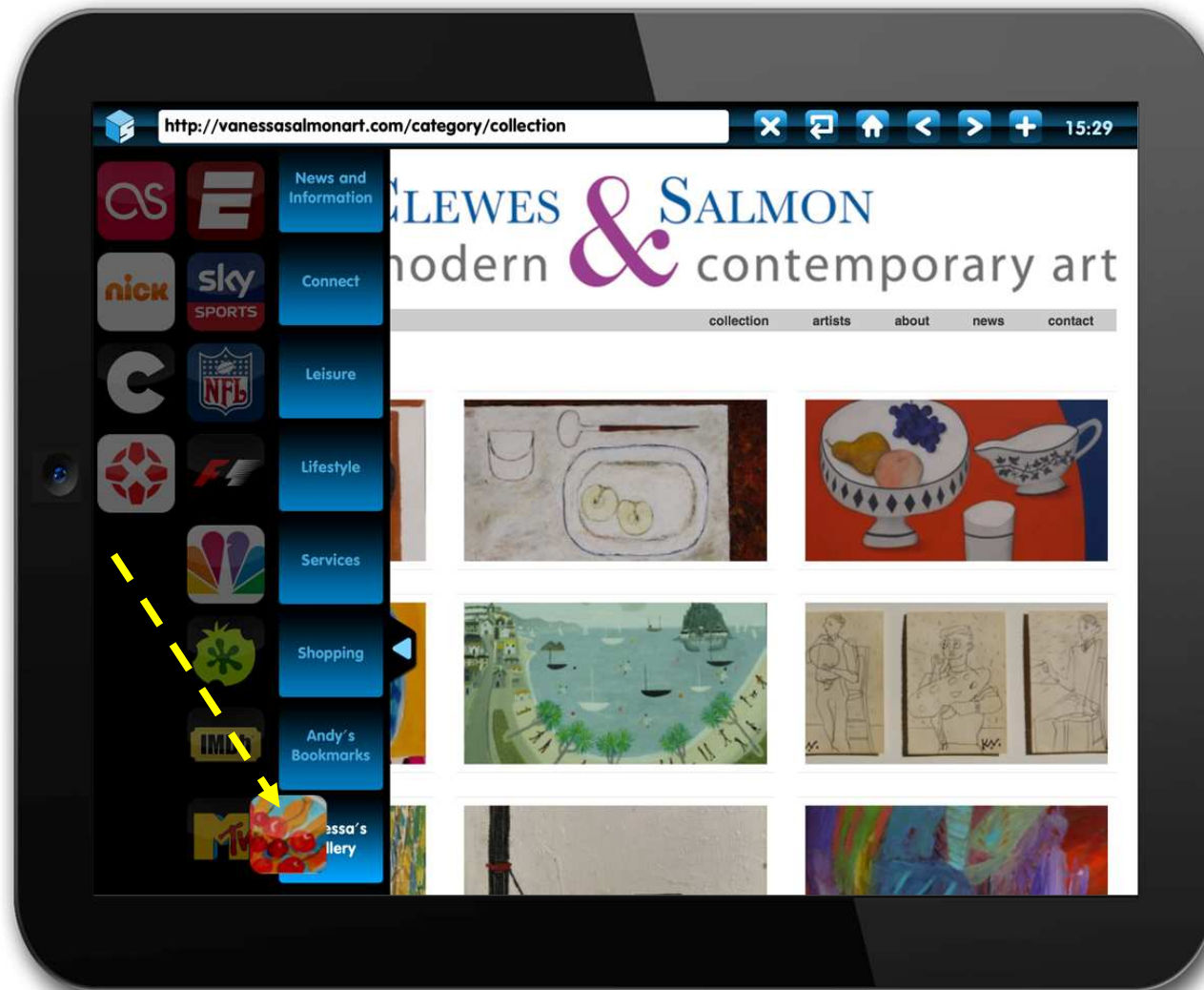
The successfully created Mycon™ is confirmed



And saved in the folder that is open, but then can be moved to any folder



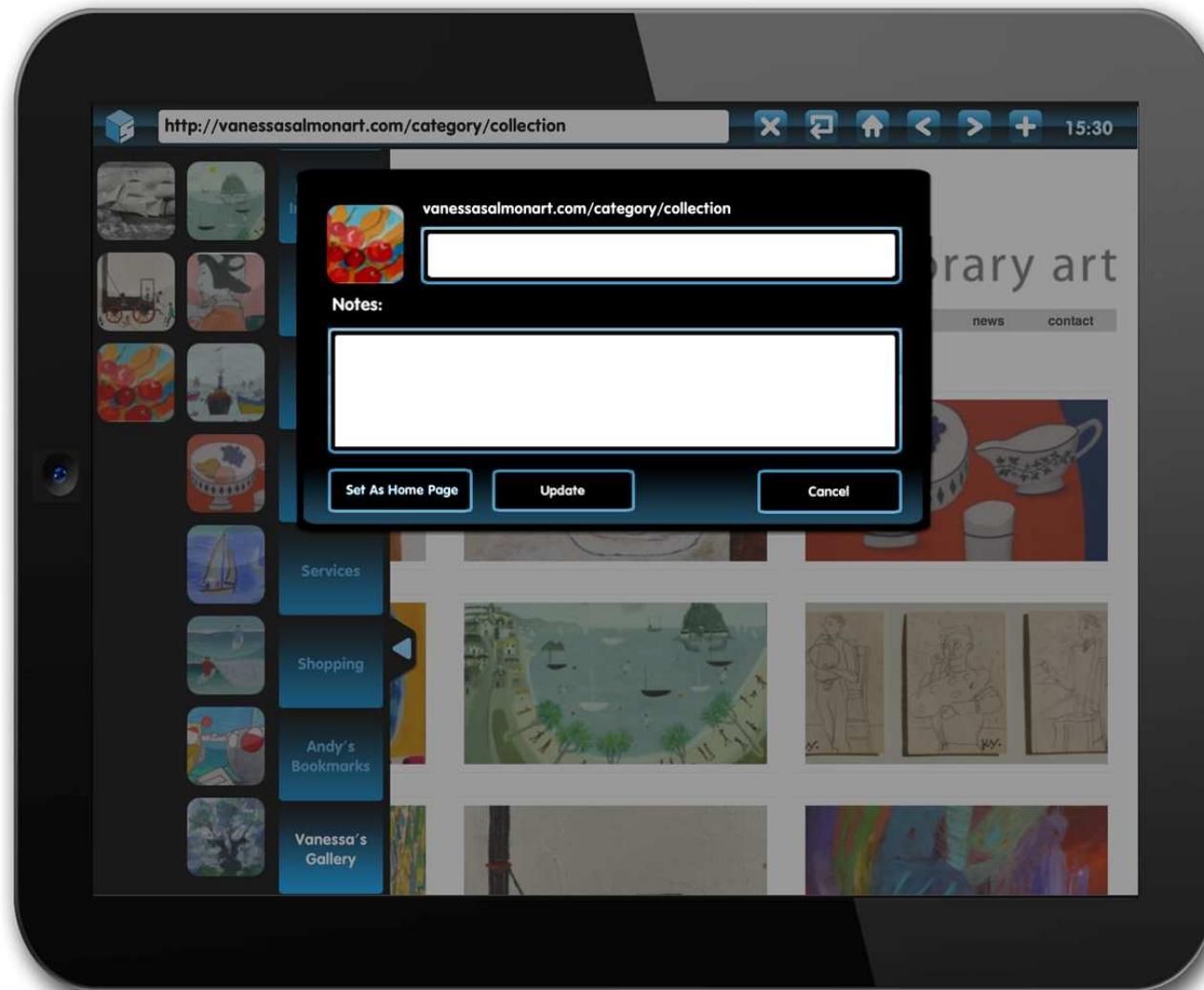
You can move a Mycon™ (or Icon) into another folder simply by pushing it



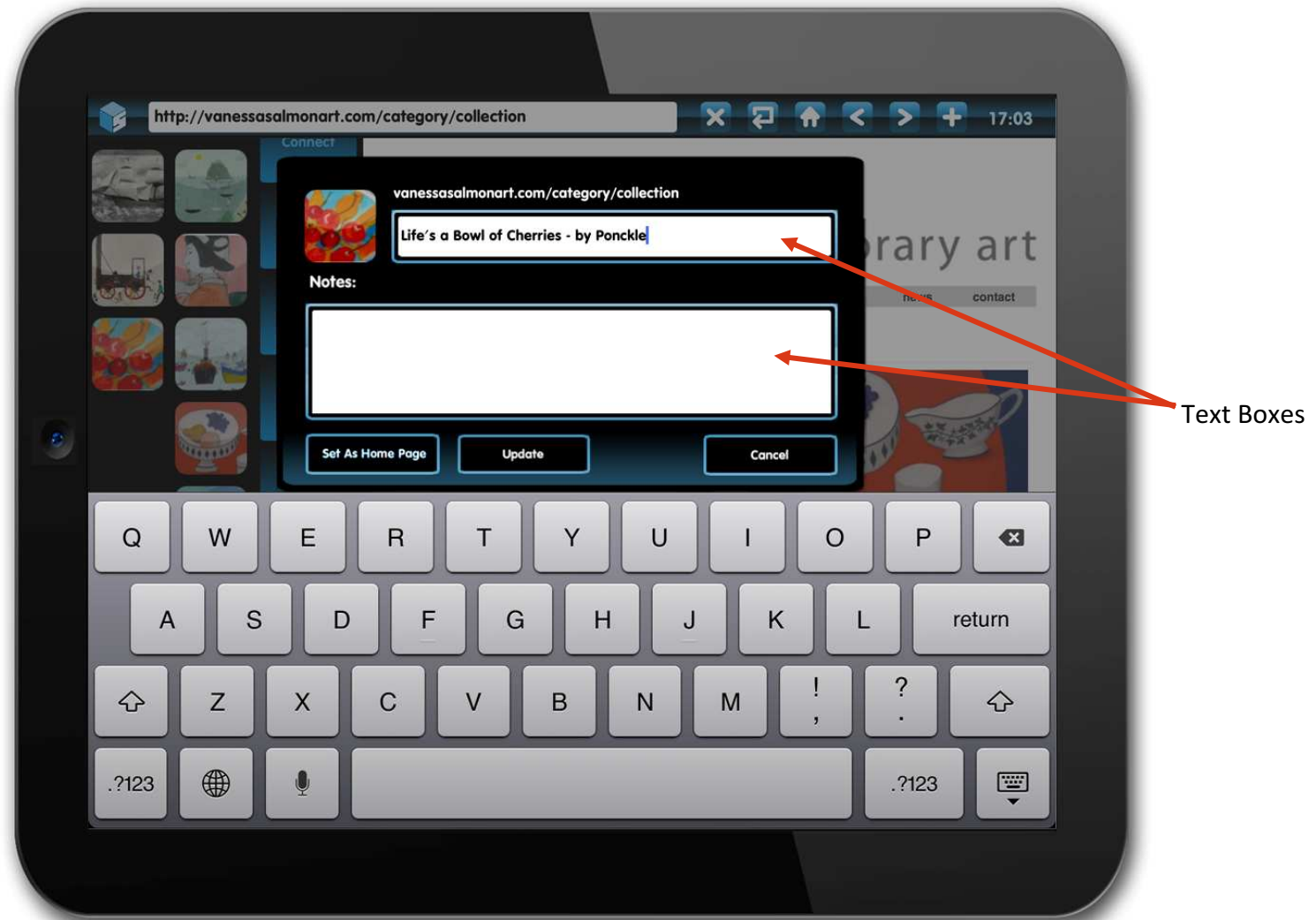
When the Mycon™ or icon is over the destination that tab becomes highlighted.
Removing your finger saves the Mycon™ to the new folder



Your Mycon™ is now saved in the customised art gallery folder to be browsed at your leisure



You can add descriptive details to the new Mycon™ by double tapping on it



You add comments in the two text boxes by tapping on them

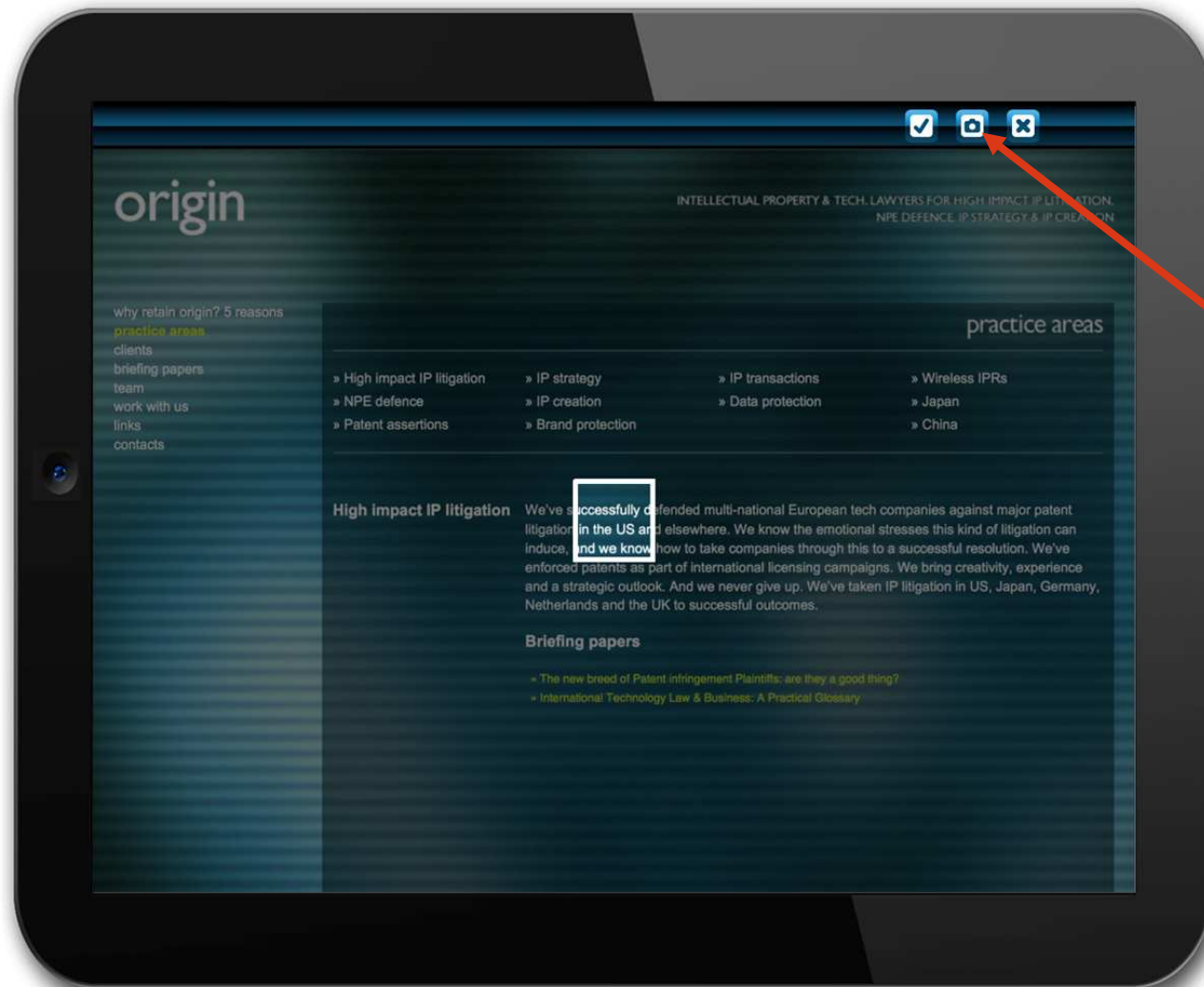


Any saved website can also be selected as your Home Page

You can also create and save a Mycon using your photos



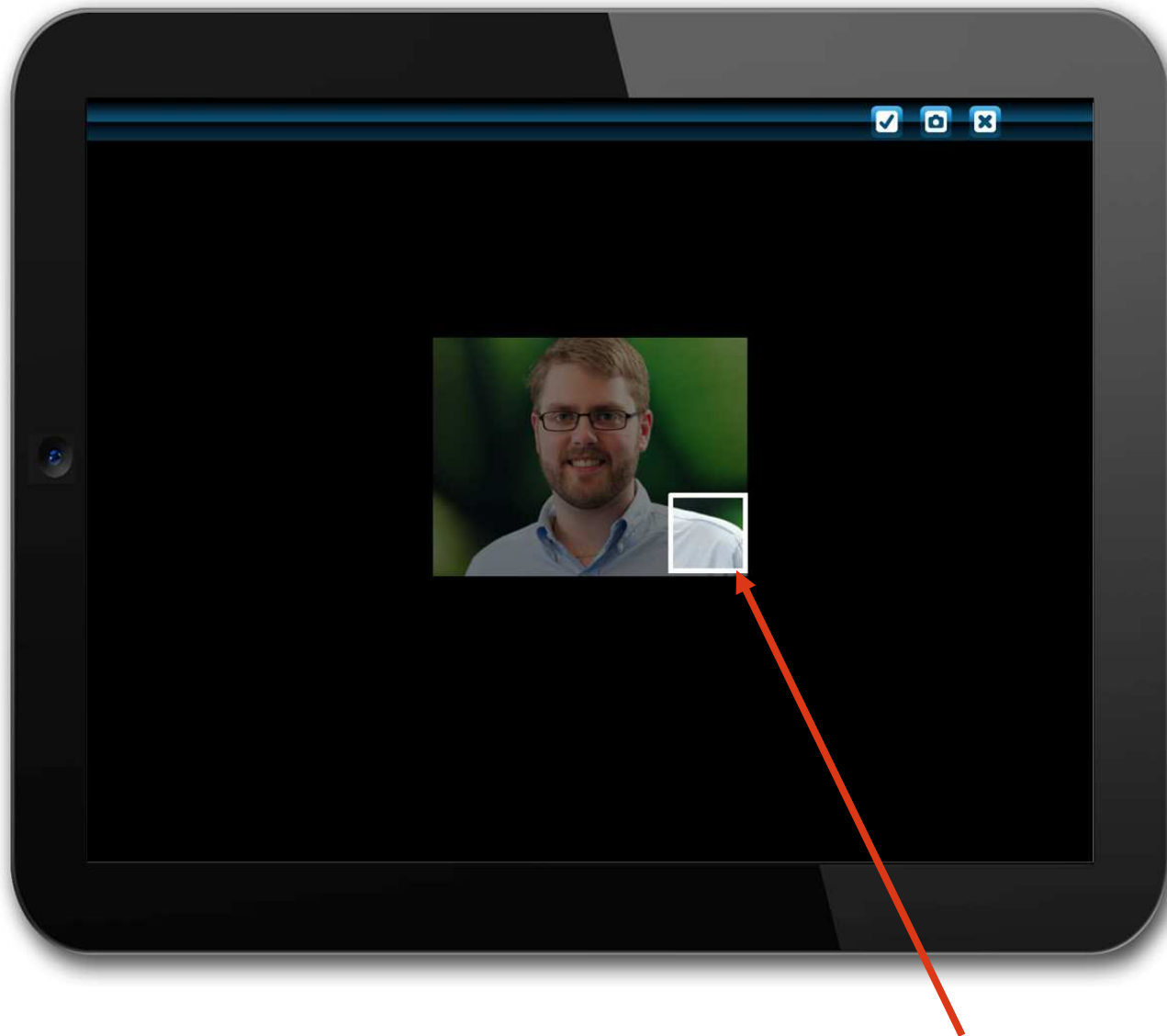
Tap on the

Your saved photos are selected by the camera control

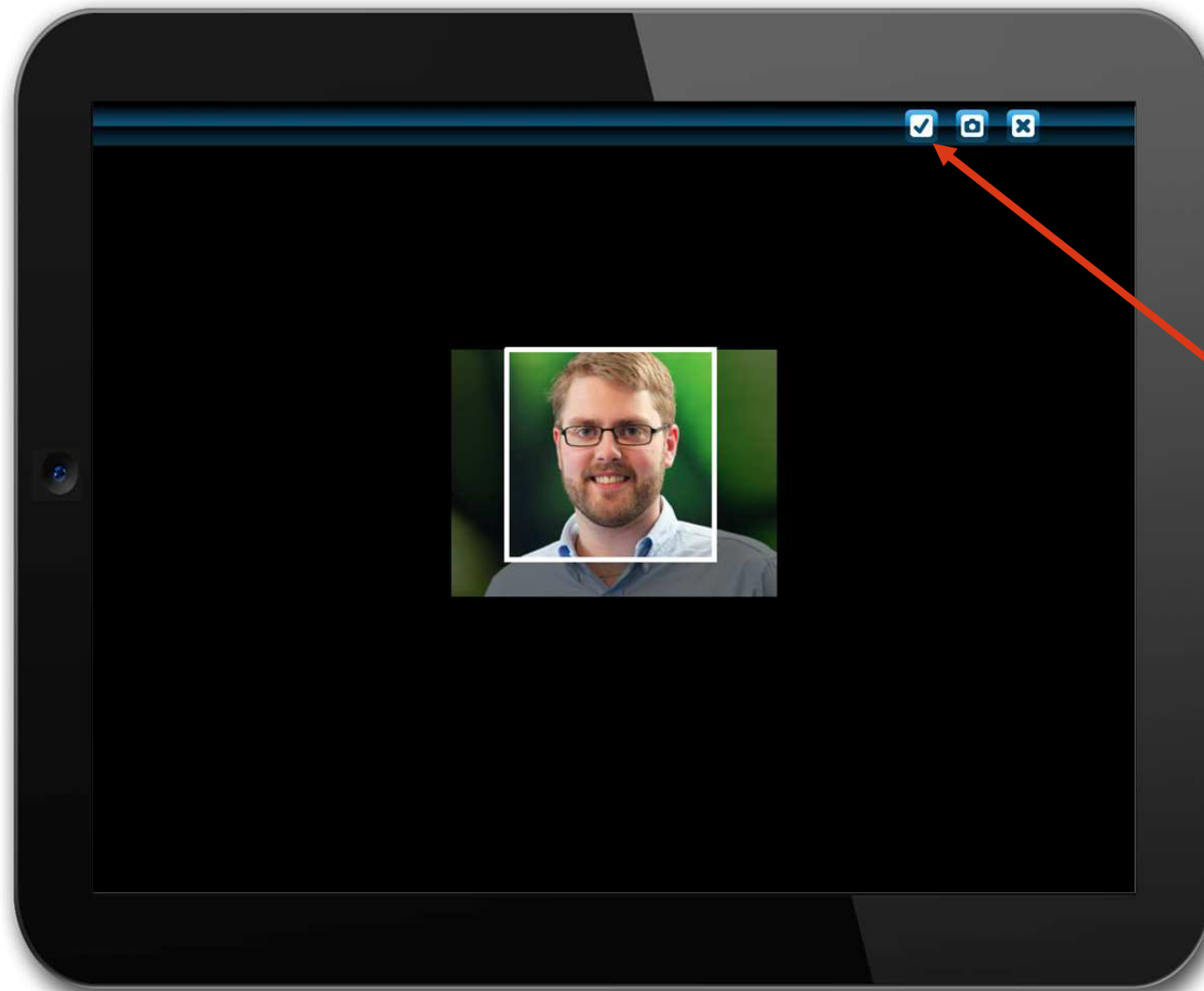


Tap to select

The selected photo is previewed with the Snap™ capture frame



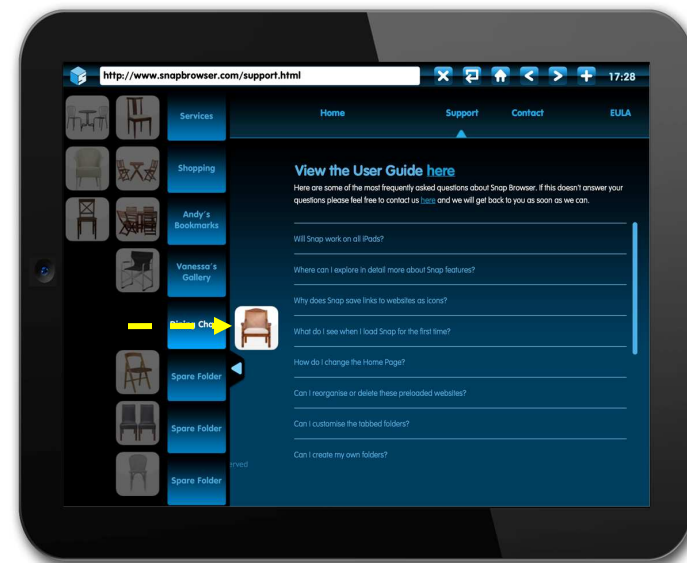
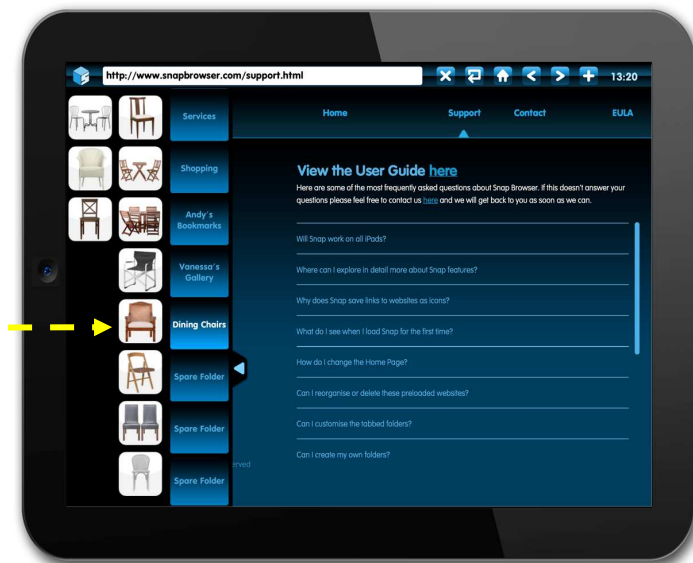
Tap to save

Select the area of the photo you want to sample – then tap on the 'OK' button

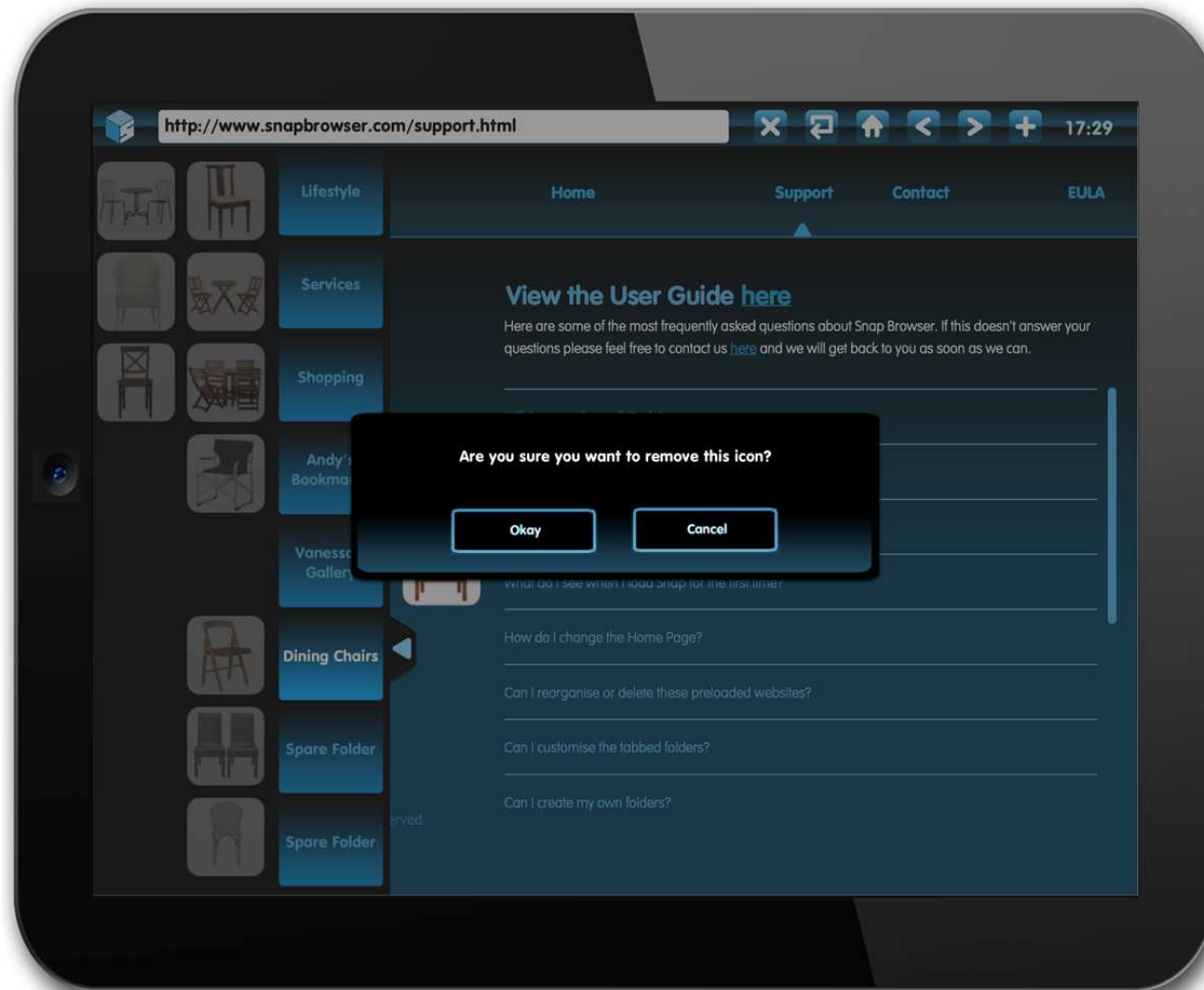

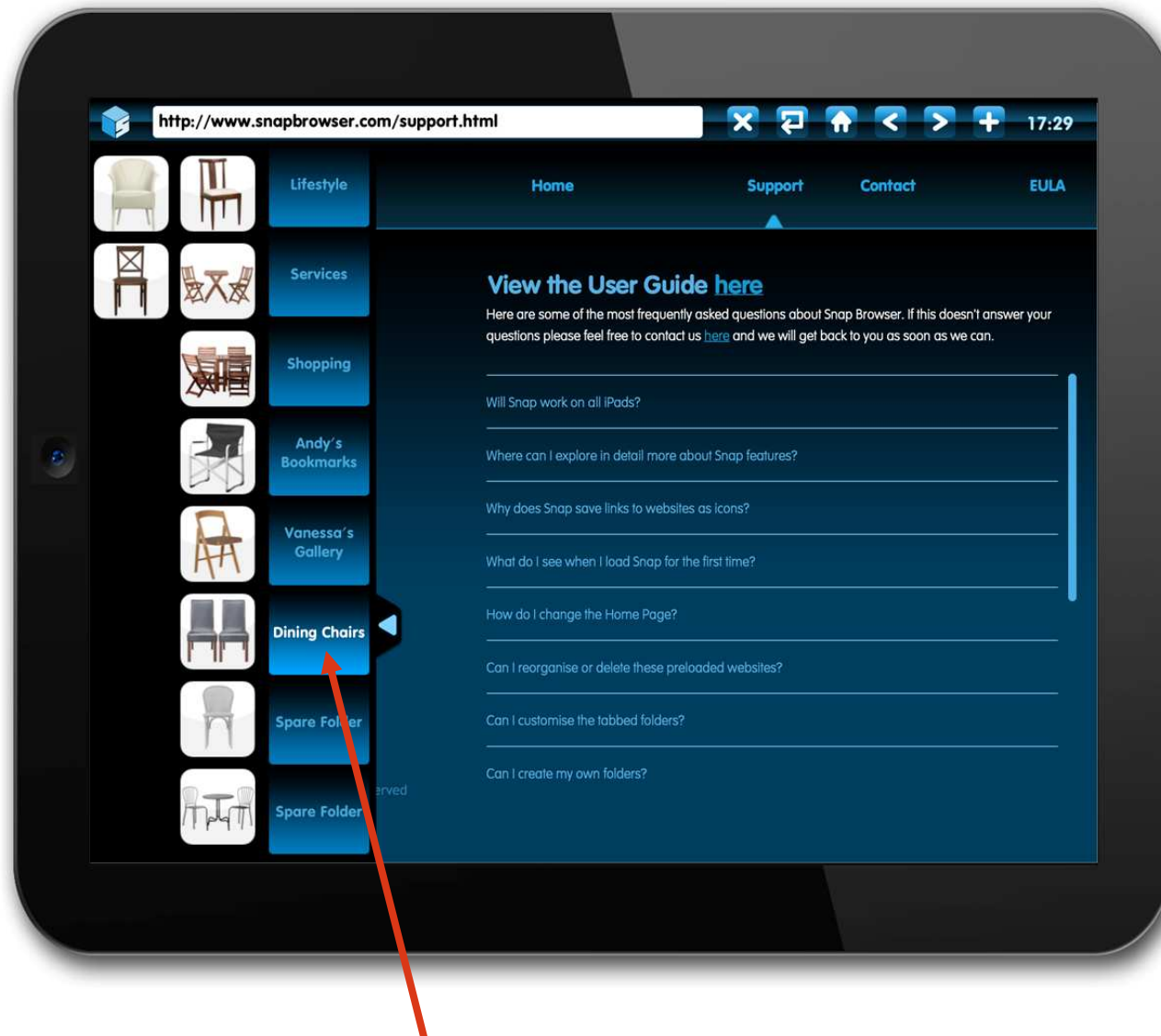
The Mycon is now saved to a folder of your choice



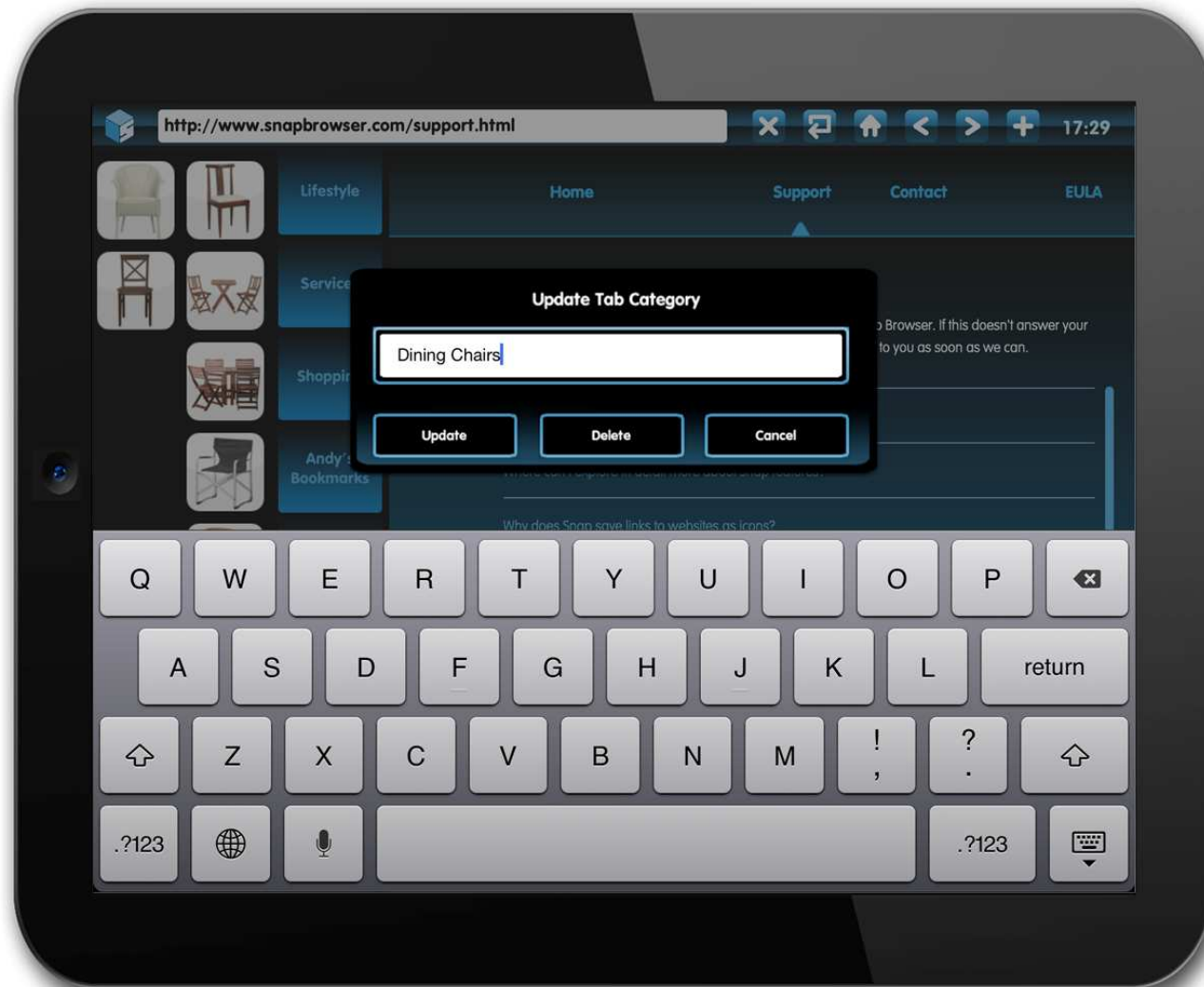
You can delete an icon or Mycon™ by pushing it into the viewing area



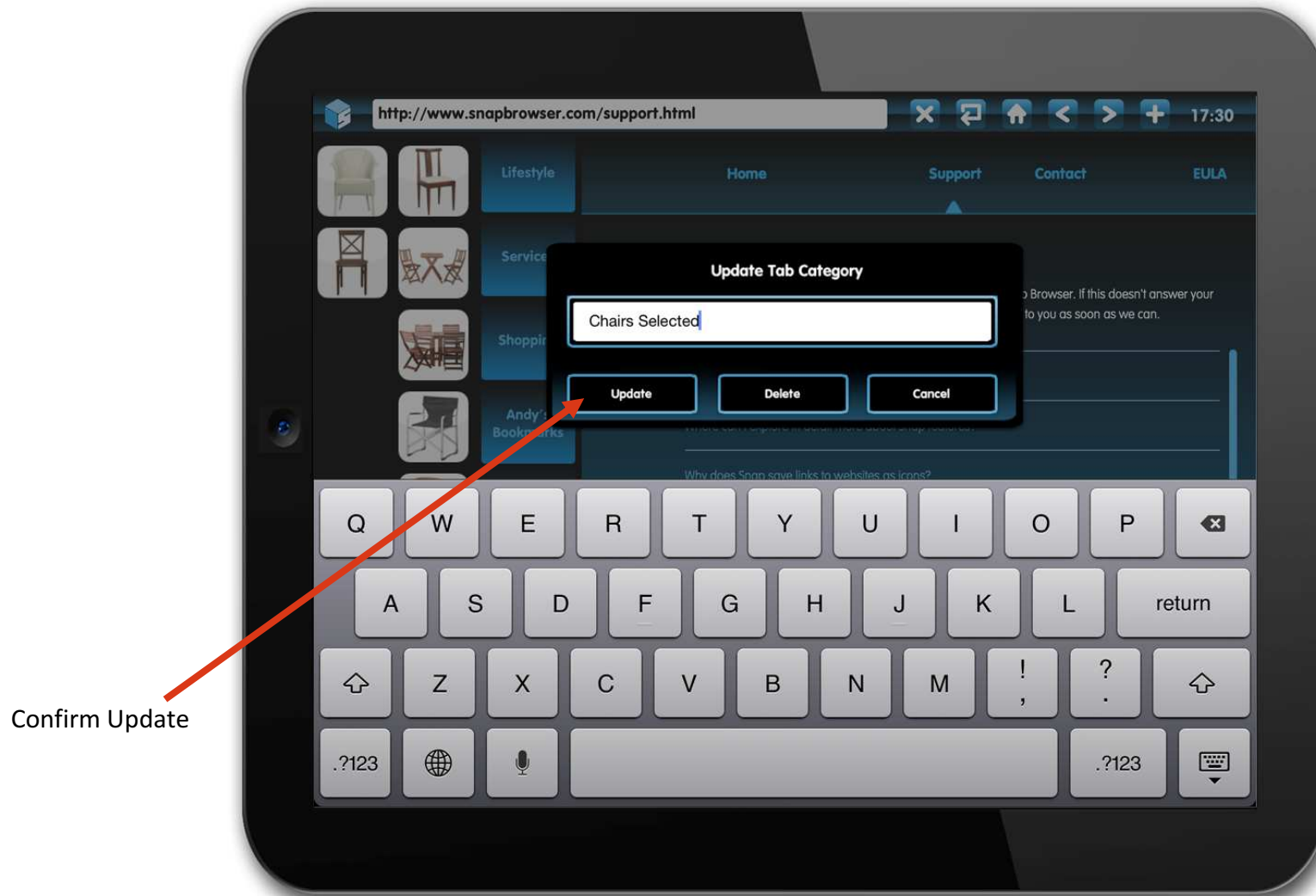
You are then asked to confirm the deletion of the website or to cancel it



To rename a folder tab you double tap on it – in this case 'Dining Chairs'

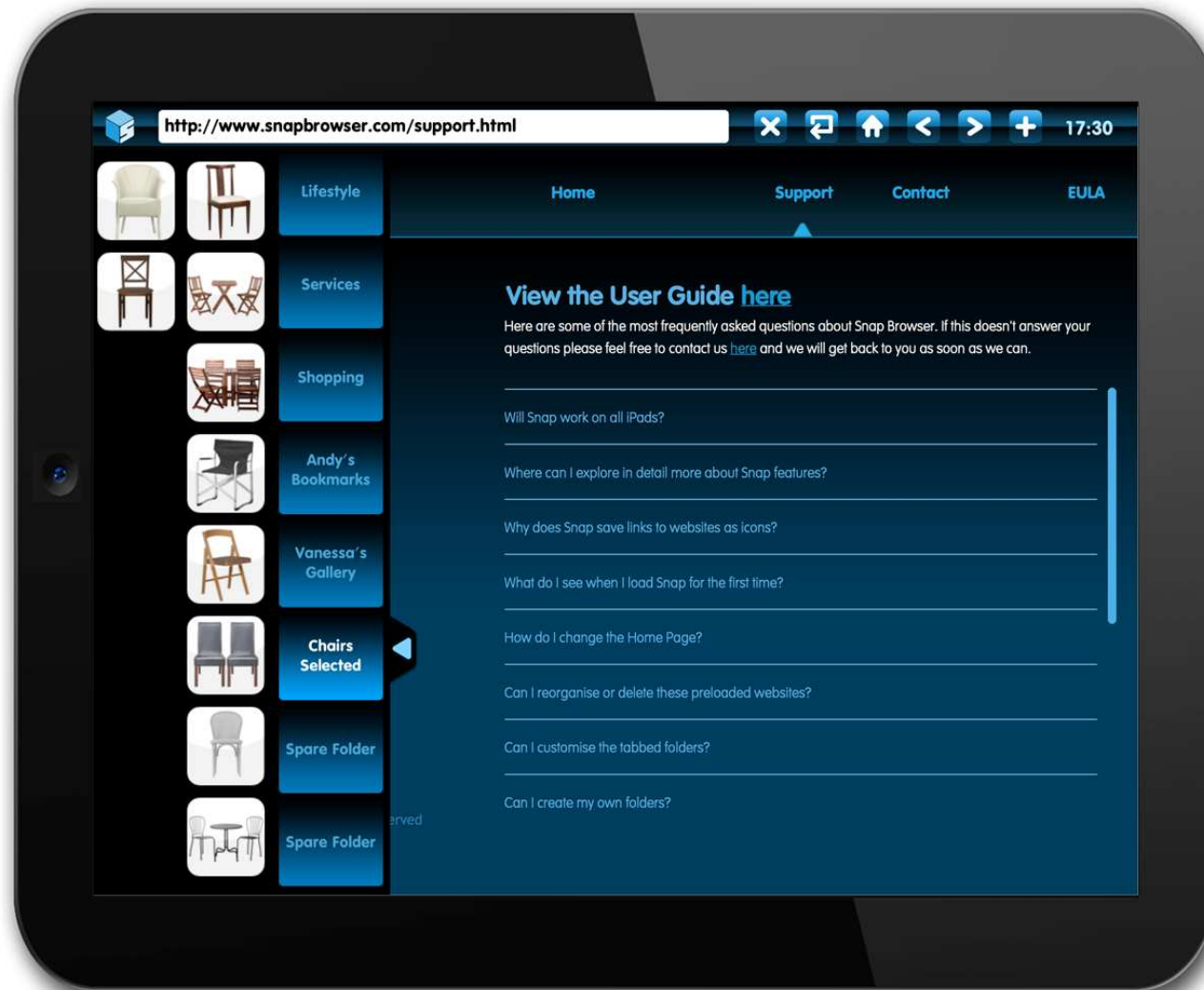


You can now enter whatever folder name you wish



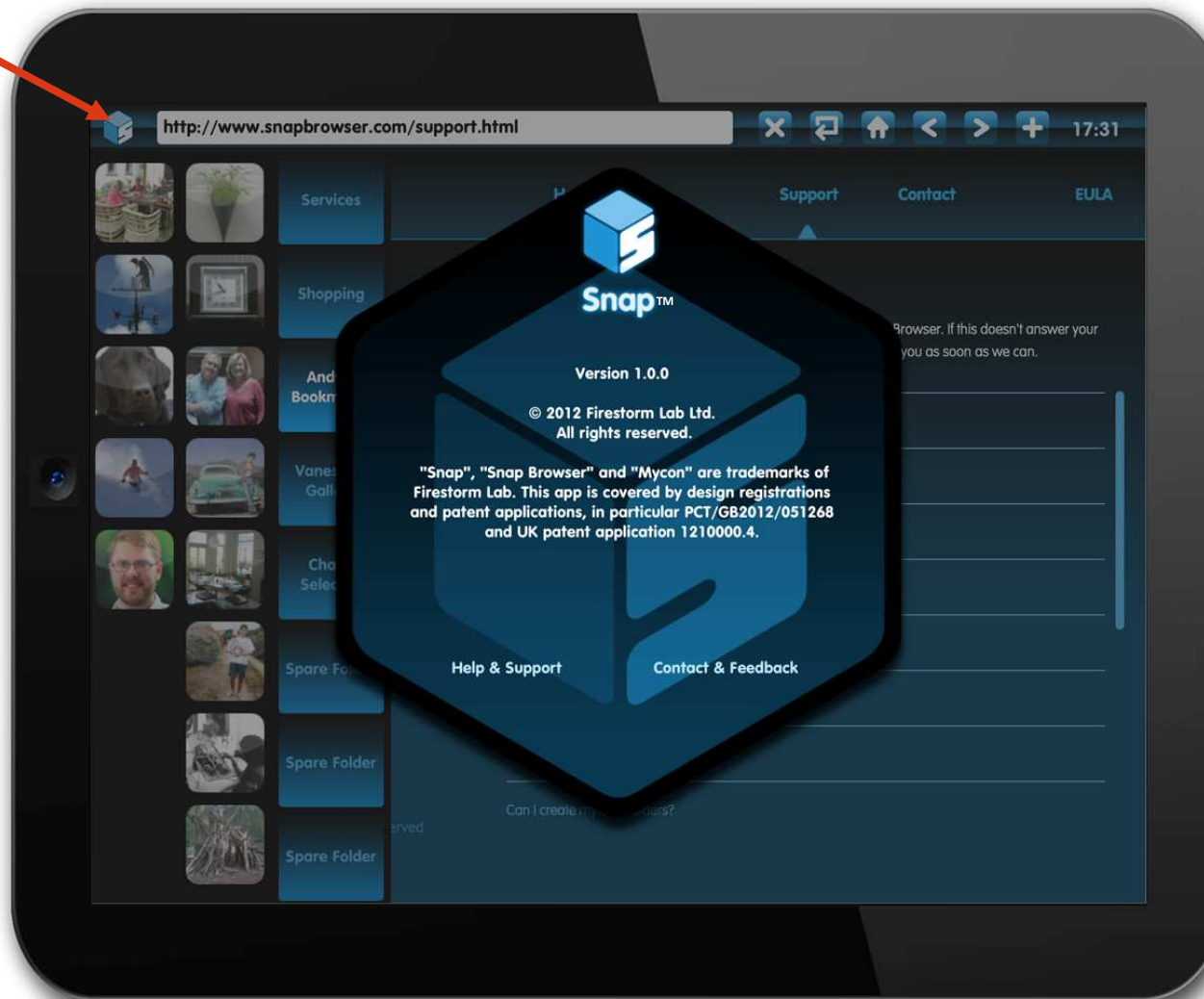
Confirm Update

You tap on the Update button to save the new tab name

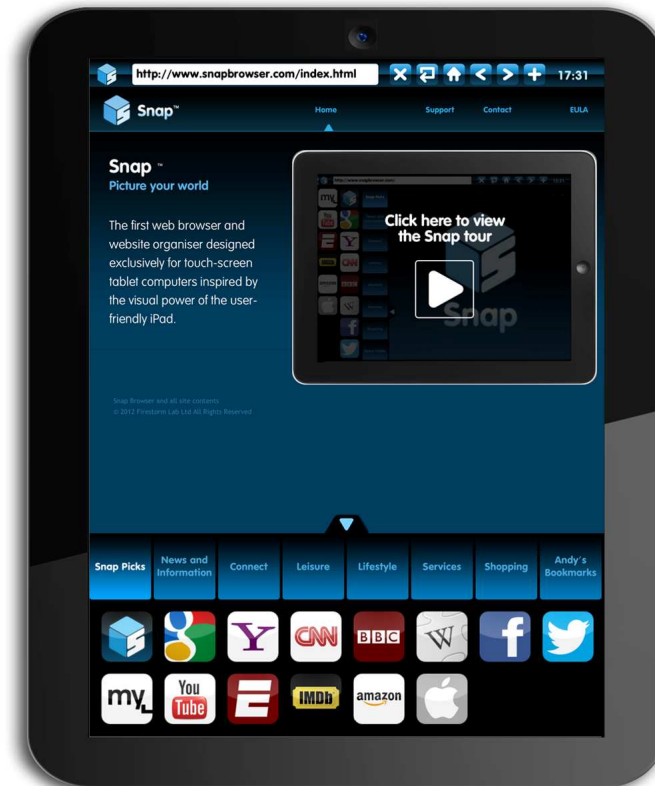


The folder has now been personalised by you
